

Currently, 44.2% of the 84,670 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 41.7%, renter occupied; and 14.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 82,298 housing units in the area - 49.1% owner occupied, 39.4% renter occupied, and 11.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.27%. Median home value in the area is \$142,213, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.82% annually to \$171,539.

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
