





Currently, 61.7% of the 36,289 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.4%, renter occupied; and 8.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant.
