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

Currently, 53.0% of the 27,390 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.5%, renter occupied; and 15.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 27,303 housing units in the area and 15.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.14%. Median home value in the area is \$122,282, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 7.99% annually to \$179,565.



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
